
### **Our Mission:**

Geoff McCreary's background includes a college degree and four years of military service. He spent his working career as a commercial roofer. Through the years, Geoff took courses in woodcarving, jewelry, and ceramics. All his creations now make use of stone, wood, beach glass, and metal. His work usually begins with one found object, usually hidden under layers of rust, grease, paint, etc. In this case, Odd Bird started with two cart wheels. Everything gets a couple coats of Danish oil, tung oil, or polyurethane. Care for Odd Bird mentions that if left outside it will deteriorate over time.
