The Neighborhood Art House Summer Session 2019

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to the Inner-City Neighborhood Art House. This is our 24th year to provide free art, music, exercise and environmental classes to children ages 7- 18. Class size is limited and the classes are filled on a first come basis. Once you submit your registration and parent form we will begin the registration process. When you are registered you will receive a post card indicating that your child/children have been accepted.

Please keep this card because it will remind you of our starting date and the weeks that your children will attend.

If for any reason your children cannot attend we request that you contact us immediately so that we can admit another child to the program. Please take advantage of our Hooked on Books Program where an adult reads to your child. Our volunteers come over their lunch break to read to the children.

Our program <u>does not</u> provide breakfast, transportation, early morning or late afternoon care. Children will have to have their breakfast at home before they come for the 10:00 class in the morning.

If your child is 10-14 and they attend morning **and** afternoon sessions, they have the opportunity to go for a hot lunch at Kids Café. Please sign up on the schedule. These students will stay for Hooked on Books, walk to Kids Café (1/2) block away and then return for afternoon classes. Afternoon classes begin at 1:30.

Children must be *picked up* at the end of classes:

Morning 12:35 (If not taking Hooked on Books then pick up is at 12:00)

Afternoon 3:30

Students must be 10 years old to come back or stay for afternoon classes.

<u>Please note that the summer program runs Monday through Friday; new classes are offered each week.</u> This is different than our after-school program which runs day by day.
