Dear Parents/Guardians: We are still in a very cautious time due to Covid-19. This is our 26th year to provide free art, music, dance, environmental, and poetry classes to youth 9-16. Class size is extremely limited since we are conforming to the Health Department and CDC 6-foot social distancing rules for everyone's safety.

Our classes are filled on a first come basis.

Beside the parent agreement form you must fill out the new COVID form for your child to attend the Art House. When your child is registered you will receive an email telling you that your child have been accepted. If for any reason your child cannot attend, please contact us immediately so that we can admit another child to the program.

We will not have Hooked on Books, Singing, Face to Face Music Lessons, Tutoring or Field Trips. A light pre-packaged snack and water will be provided when your child enters the building.

Arrival--Please arrive on time and enter through Door #4
Classes begin at 3:15. If you arrive after 3:15 you must use door #1
Dismissal—Time Varies at Door #5.
All students will be picked up at the end of the building—Door #5

Please note that the Winter-Spring program runs day to day.
Many classes are 2 hours long please be sure that your child is a serious student
and is interested in the class. The class size is limited to 4-6 students.

If a teacher is unable to teach the class that class will be cancelled for the day.
You will receive a phone call or a note to that effect. We are unable to switch your child to another class.
